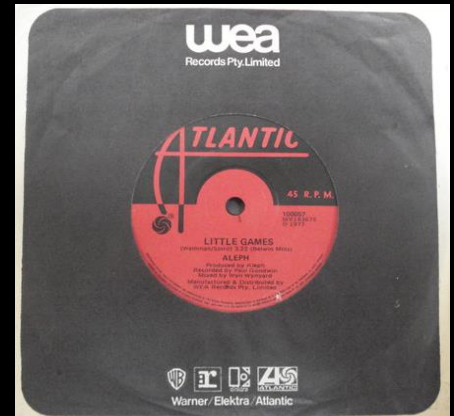

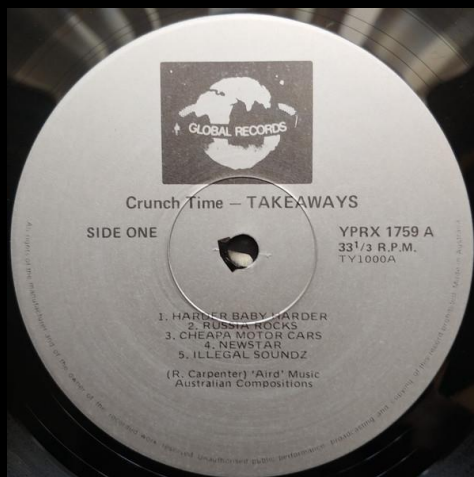

NB: The album cover and labels confusingly identify the album as either *Crunch Time* or *Crunch Time Snax*. On the front, for example, is *Takeaways* (-) 's *Crunch Time*, while on the spine is printed *Crunch Time Snax*. The back cover has *Takeaways: Crunch Time Snax*, but the labels on both Side 1 and Side 2 of the record identify the album as simply *Crunch Time*.
